- Protecting workers from reprisals when reporting incidents, Occupational hazards, risks and opportunities.
- Ensuring the organisation has established and implements processes for consultation and participation of workers.
- Improving employee engagement through the establishment of the Health and Safety Committee in 2019.
- Maintain our premises and work equipment to a standard that ensures that risks are effectively managed.
- Retaining access to competent advice and assistance through the support of external consultants, thereby ensuring that all are aware of relevant changes in legislation and 'Good Practice'.
